## WHAT TO BRING

### BEDDING

- 1 sleeping bag or bed roll (2 sheets and 2 blankets)
- 1 pillow

### CLOTHES

- Pants
- 1 T-shirt per day
- 1 sweater or sweatshirt
- 1 light jacket
- 1 rain coat or poncho
- 2 pairs of closed-toed shoes
- 1 pair of underwear per day
- 2 pairs of socks per day
- 1 hat or cap
- 1 pair of pajamas
- Swimsuit (Thursdays at Lake Tahoe)

### TOILETRIES

- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Comb/brush
- Towel & Washcloth
- Beach towel
- Body soap, shampoo, conditioner

### OTHER

- Small day pack
- Sunscreen and bug repellent
- Reusable water bottle
- Sunglasses
- Binoculars (optional)
- Flashlight (optional)
- Large plastic bag—for dirty laundry
- Book for silent reading

## WHAT NOT TO BRING

As a general rule, do not bring anything that you would not bring to your school. Anything in this category will be taken from the camper and kept by staff until departure.

- Candy, gum, food of any kind
- Knives, hatchets, ANY weapons
- Fireworks
- Fire starting supplies
- ANY electronic devices, including handheld games, radios, music players, iPads, cameras, **cell phones**, etc.
- Money
- Perfume/cologne
- Bear Spray

**MAKE SURE ALL ITEMS ARE MARKED WITH CAMPER'S NAME.**

**ONLY BRING OLD CLOTHES—NEW CLOTHES MAY BE RUINED BY HEAVY OUTDOOR USE.**
