## OTHER

Backpacking on National forest lands is permitted May-October. Permits are not currently required to camp in Mt Rose Wilderness area, however campfire permits are required. The water is contaminated with *Giardia lamblia* and *Cryptosporidium*. Groups over 15 are not permitted.
